U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS.gov) welcomed more than 7.2 million naturalized citizens into the fabric of the nation. In fiscal year 2018, over 756,000 people were naturalized to become US citizens. This population enrolls students into the school system every year. Most of them demand heritage language education, however schools do not have the means to meet this education need.

National Security Education Program (NSEP.gov) emphasizes study of languages critical to U.S. national security. National Security Language Initiative (NSLI) coordinated by the State Department, Education Department, Defense Department, and the Director of National Intelligence targets increasing the number of Americans mastering critical languages. Many government initiatives demonstrate the importance of expanding the critical language education in U.S. schools.

Despite the real needs for critical language education, schools cannot afford serving these student segments either because of lack of qualified teachers or because of the prohibitive cost to teach multiple languages to a small number of students in each school.

Noorann Modern Education, a non-profit organization, promotes the Critical Language Education using a comprehensive framework. Over the last five years, the organization developed advanced modern methodologies and linguistic technology products and setup a process to hire, train, certify, and manage remote tutors to carry on our mission. The curriculum uses interactive multimedia interfaces and brings the teaching of the critical language to the same standards as other subjects. We have been running the program with a great success for native and non-native language speakers of all ages. The student onboarding placement test and the exit evaluation are done by independent evaluator to ensure accurate program assessment.

Our program benefits students seeking to learn critical foreign languages either to start Early Learning of foreign languages using English language or receive high school World Language credits. We can help ELL students learning English language using their native mother-tongue as needed. communication, social, and mental skills. The program activities are designed to improve memorization and problem-solving capabilities.

The organization started deploying the program in private schools and community centers successfully in the State of Washington. The program deployment formats include 1) **Remote tutoring** provides remote tutors to teach the students using the online curriculum and the organization infrastructure with minimal administration efforts from schools 2) **Resident teacher** is suitable for schools with high concentration of students interested in a critical language where the school hires a teacher who will rely on the online curriculum and organization training support 3) **Self-guided studying** depends on the online curriculum and the organization tools with the help of parents and communities to provide the tutoring with a minimal involvement from the school and an occasional remote tutoring by the organization. The first option is the most common and most effective to achieve high quality results. See attached sample invoices detailing the above options.

During COVID-19 lockdown, our program continued to provide services while schools were closed. The program design with full support to remote learning allowed schools to administer the program with no interruption. Moving forward, the program with its infrastructure can become an important program to add address student needs.

Currently, we are trying to expand our operations by partnering with schools to deploy our program. Our organization plans to apply for a grant from ed.gov to enable students to learn critical language in schools across the U.S. Schools showing interest in participating in the program will become partners in the grant and will not accrue any cost during the program period of 5 years.
